Overview:

The fire remained active during the night, expanding an additional 500 acres. Additional resources arrived throughout the night. The fire behavior remains intense. Structures are threatened and currently mandatory evacuations are in place. Structure defense continues. Terrain is grassy oak woodland, heavy brush with difficult access.

Evacuations: Clayton Creek Rd., Morgan Valley Rd. at Bonham to Butte Rock Ranch, North Spruce Grove Road to Black Bass Pass Rd.

Advisory Evacuations: Jerusalem Grade Road

Road Closures: Clayton Creek Rd. at Hwy 29 , Morgan Valley Road at Bonham to the Napa Countyline, North Spruce Grove Road and South Spruce Grove Road off Hwy 29.
