SITUATION

Current Situation:	Overnight firefighters continued to mop up and secure more of the fires perimeter. Damage Inspection Teams continue to survey the fire area to determine how many structures have been damaged or destroyed. Current data indicates that the fire has destroyed 268 structures; including 200 single-family homes, 21 mixed use residential structures, 13 commercial structures, 10 multi-family dwellings, and 72 other structures such as sheds and smaller outbuildings.
