Yesterday, firefighters continued mop up operations. A fire weather watch is in effect from Tuesday afternoon through Tuesday evening for gusty winds and low humidity for portions of northeast California. Today, firefighters will continue to patrol the fire, extinguishing any hot spots and ensuring fire lines are secure. Fire suppression repair crews will continue today to minimize the effects of the fire's damage.

Continue to watch for slow-moving firefighting equipment on the roadway in and around the fire area.
