### SITUATION

<b>Current Situation:</b>	Last night fire crews continued to make progress towards full containment of the fire. Suppression repair and erosion control measures continued. Crews will remain throughout the fire perimeter into next week to continue patrolling and mopping up. We urge those who do not have homes and/or businesses in the area to stay out. As fire crews and equipment remain in the fire area, please drive slowly and use caution.
<b>Evacuations:</b>	<b>Santa Clara County:</b> The mandatory evacuation orders for the Loma Prieta ridgeline area including all tributary roads along Summit Road east of Soquel San Jose Road to Ormsby Fire Station including Loma Chiquita and Loma Prieta Road. Casa Loma northeast of Twin Falls Creek Road has been re-opened to residents.
