#### *Current Situation*

##### Overview:

Firefighters have made significant progress throughout the evening working a vegetation fire in the western hills of Napa Valley West of Yountville. The fire on steep brush covered slopes significantly threatened one structure in its early stages. With favorable weather conditions this evening and in the forecast firefighters expect to continue making progress toward containment. Evacuation orders for the Campbell Creek and Campbell Flat area will remain in place throughout the night. An evacuation center is available at the Crosswalk Church at 2590 1st street in Napa.

Evacuations: Campbell Creek and Campbell Flat area

Road Closures: Dry Creek Road in the Area of the fire.
