### Current Situation

Unified command has been established with the USFS, and CAL FIRE. Heavy precipitation is occurring over the fire area and wind is impacting firefighting operations. Forward progress of the fire has been stopped. The removal of hazardous trees from Highway 89 and around residences is ongoing. Debris continues to impact the roadway due to the high winds and torrential rains. Fire suppression repair continues on the fire where safe. Liberty Utilities has restored power to the following areas; Cascade Properties, Cascade Lake, Camp Shelly, Camp Concord, Cathedral Side of Fallen Leaf Lake, Taylor Creek Visitors Center, Baldwin Beach, Taylor Creek STPUD Pump. Some areas will continue to be without power including Spring Creek Tract & and a part of Cascade Properties.

**Evacuations: Mandatory-** Spring Creek, Cathedral, West shore of Fallen Leaf Lake, Cascade Properties, Cascade Lake. **Evacuations have been released North of Bayview Trailhead all others are still in place.**

**Evacuation Shelter:** South Lake Tahoe Recreation Center evacuation shelter is now closed.
