Headlines:

- The **EVACUATION ORDER** for the Peachtree community has been lifted.
- Hwy 154 is open to general traffic. The speed limit will be reduced to 45 MPH and will be strictly enforced.
- An informational meeting on the Zaca Fire will be held in Ojai on Friday, August 10. The meeting will begin at 7 pm at the Matilija Middle School, 730 El Paseo Road.
- Two informational meetings on the Zaca Fire will be held on Saturday August 11 in the Lebec/Frazier Park area. At 12 noon a meeting will be held at the Pine Mountain Club, 2534 Beechwood Way and at 3pm at the Frazier Mountain High School, 700 Falcon Way, Lebec.

Current Situation:

The fire will be active today due to increased temperature, lower humidity, and decreased marine layer. The fire is established in the Indian Creek Campground, Poplar Campground areas, Rattlesnake Canyon, west of Samon Peak and Alamar Canyon area. Significant amounts of smoke might be seen due to burning operations and fire activity. Hand crews, engines, and dozers will continue with contingency lines in the areas of Paradise, East Camino Cielo, Sierra Madre Ridge, the Pendola Road, Matilija Wilderness, Dry Canyon and south of Hwy 33 to Divide Peak.

Forest, Road and Area Closures:

- Happy Canyon Road is closed at Los Padres National Forest boundary
- Figueroa Mountain Road is closed at the Los Padres National Forest boundary
- East Camino Cielo at Painted Cave Road.
- Paradise Road at Stagecoach Road (near the Paradise Store). No public traffic will be allowed on Paradise Road or eastbound on Stagecoach Road towards the Cold Springs Bridge. Stagecoach Road will be closed to all traffic near the underside of the Cold Springs Bridge.
- 649,000 acres of the Los Padres National Forest are closed. More info at www.inciweb.org

Evacuations:

An **Evacuation Order** is in effect for Paradise Road and Lower Santa Ynez River to Gibraltar Dam. This includes Paradise Road Community, Santa Ynez Road Recreational Area to Gibraltar Dam, Los Prietos Boys Camp, and the Rancho Oso Guest Ranch.
