<b>Current Situation:</b>	Firefighters have worked throughout the day to establish control lines. Fire weather conditions remain critical. Extreme fire behavior has been observed. Shifting winds have created numerous active portions of the fire that have the potential to increase fire spread.

<b>Road Closures:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Northbound County Road 87 from Highway 128</li> <li>• Berryessa Knoxville Road, from the Pope Creek Bridge to the Napa/Lake County line</li> <li>• Eastbound Highway 128 at Markley Resort</li> <li>• Westbound Highway 128 at Pleasant Valley Road</li> <li>• Pleasant Valley Road, South from Highway 128 remains open to serve traffic into Solano County</li> </ul>
