CURRENT SITUATION

Current Situation:	Firefighters worked aggressively through the day to build containment lines around the County Fire. Their efforts have been hampered on the northern end of the fire by steep, inaccessible terrain. While cooler temperatures are expected through tomorrow, winds and dry vegetation still have the potential to fuel fire growth.
