## CURRENT SITUATION

<b>Current Situation:</b>	Firefighters will continue to work aggressively through the night to build containment lines around the County Fire. Steep and inaccessible terrain has created difficulty for firefighters on the Northern end of the fire. There was a slight increase in fire activity today. Damage inspections have been initiated and are ongoing. The number of damaged and destroyed structures reflected may change throughout the process. The weather will become hotter and drier into the weekend and fire growth potential remains high.
