### **FIREFIGHTERS CONTINUE TO BATTLE LICK FIRE**

The Lick Fire burned an additional 1000 acres last night. Located just East of Morgan Hill, the fire is burning in Henry W. Coe State Park. As of this morning, a total of 11,000 acres have been charred. Crews are focusing their suppression efforts on the West side of the fire today in preparation for an expected shift in wind direction. The forecast calls for winds to come from the North and Northeast during the day.

- The fire started shortly before 2PM on September 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- The fire is burning in grass, heavy brush and oak woodlands.
- The fire is now 20 percent contained
- The fire destroyed 1 outbuilding.
- 25 residential units and ten outbuildings are threatened
- There are now 1298 personnel on the incident
- There have been four firefighter injuries. One firefighter was airlifted to the hospital yesterday with a heat related injury.
- The cause remains under investigation.
