FIREFIGHTERS CONTINUE TO MAKE GOOD PROGRESS ON LICK FIRE

The Lick Fire has burned a total of 18,905 acres in and near Henry W. Coe State Park. Crews today will continue to face challenges related to access, terrain and low relative humidity.

- The fire started shortly before 2 PM on September 3rd.
- The fire is burning in grass, heavy brush and oak woodlands.
- Winds are expected to be light today from the West.
- The fire is 25% contained.
- The fire has destroyed 1 outbuilding.
- 25 residential units and ten outbuildings are threatened
- There are now 1,756 personnel on the incident
- The DC 10 air tanker is expected to be used on the incident today.
- There have been four firefighter injuries
- The estimated cost of the fire to date is 1,839,944.
- The fire originated from within a debris barrel.
