### **FIREFIGHTERS LICK FIRE**

The Lick Fire has burned a total of 27,000 acres in and near Henry W. Coe State Park. Even with the increased in acreage, crews were able to extend the lines of containment.

- The fire started shortly before 2 PM on September 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- The fire is burning in grass, heavy brush and oak woodlands.
- Winds were generally cooperative during suppression efforts today.
- The fire is 35% contained.
- The fire has destroyed 1 outbuilding.
- 25 residential units and ten outbuildings are threatened
- There are now 1,851 personnel on the incident
- Air tankers could not be used today because of reduced visibility. Helicopters were utilized.
- There have been four firefighter injuries
- The estimated cost of the fire to date is 3,333,940
- The fire originated from within an illegal debris barrel.
