LICK FIRE HAS NOW BURNED 10,000 ACRES

As of 7PM, the Lick Fire has burned 10,000 acres in steep, rugged terrain East of Morgan Hill in Henry Coe State Park. Access to the fire continues to be a problem for fire crews. The eastern part of the park has been evacuated.

- The fire started shortly before 2PM on September 3rd.
- The fire is burning in heavy brush and oak woodlands.
- The fire is now 20 percent contained
- The fire is moving toward the Southeast.
- The wind is expected to shift tomorrow
- The fire destroyed 1 outbuilding.
- 25 residential units and ten outbuildings are threatened
- There are now close to 1298 personnel on the incident
- There have been four firefighter injuries. One firefighter was airlifted to the hospital with a heat related injury.
- The cause remains under investigation.
