LICK FIRE SCORCHES 5,000 ACRES

As of 7AM, the Lick Fire has burned 5,000 acres in steep, rugged terrain East of Morgan Hill in Henry Coe State Park. Access to the fire continues to be a problem for fire crews. The eastern part of the park has been evacuated.

- The fire started shortly before 2PM on September 3rd.
- The fire is burning in heavy brush and oak woodlands.
- The fire is 10 percent contained
- The fire is moving toward the Southeast.
- The fire destroyed 1 outbuilding.
- Ten residential units and five outbuildings are threatened
- 727 personnel are assigned to the fire with more expected to arrive today. Up to 1200 firefighters may be on the incident by tomorrow.
- The DC-10 may be used today to assist with the suppression effort
- There have been two firefighter injuries.
- The cause is under investigation.
