CARR FIRE REPOPULATION

WHAT: REPOPULATION

WHEN: July 31, 2018 at 11:00

WHERE: Evacuation orders have been lifted and residents may return home in the following areas

The communities of Summit City and Buckeye to include the following areas listed below

Lake Blvd north of Oasis Road to the Shasta Dam

Pine Grove Ave. west from Iron Horse Road to Lake Blvd.

Walker Mine Road to the overhead powerlines. All residences on Walker Mine Road west of the overhead powerlines remain under mandatory evacuations.

Quartz Hill road from Lake Blvd. just west of Counter Lane will be open. A closure will be in effect at Quartz Hill Road west of Counter Lane. All residences west of this closure point will remain under mandatory evacuations.

The public is asked to limit traffic in these areas to residents only.

NOTES: **SAFETY MESSAGE** – The public is reminded to stay vigilant on current fire conditions. Please continue to adhere to road closures and any evacuation warnings. A reminder to drive slowly and yield to emergency personnel in the area. There will still be smoke in the respective areas as firefighters continue firefighting operations. If at any time you feel unsafe, please call 911.
