CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	Today's fire activity was tempered by smoke overhead. Heavy timber areas and steep drainages are still challenging firefighting efforts. Crews will work through the night to mitigate potential spot fires over control lines. Repopulation of residents affected by evacuations will continue as conditions permit.
