CURRENT SITUATION	
Situation Summary:	Firefighters continue to improve containment lines, while mop-up and patrol efforts continued throughout the less active areas. Fire spread is driven by the fuel and topography, with high potential for roll out, and spot fires. Hot and dry conditions, with gusty winds, calls for a Red Flag Warning for the fire area through 11:00 P.M. tonight.
