Current Situation: The fire is still actively burning in and around the community of Julian. Fire crews will be continuing to put in containment lines to secure the fire. There is a Red Flag Warning in effect until 9:00 PM this evening. Increased winds combined with low humidity and moderate temperatures will provide a challenge for firefighters.

Road Closures: Numerous road closures are in effect being coordinated by the California Highway Patrol and the San Diego County Sheriffs Department.

Evacuations: Evacuations were initiated over night in Cedar Glen and Lower Banner Grade. Evacuation centers have been established at Ramona High School and Borrego Springs High School. Animals have been evacuated to the Ramona Rodeo Grounds.

Additional Information: Residents are encouraged to monitor the fire situation and to be prepared for changing fire conditions. If an evacuation order is issued residents should follow all instructions of fire and law enforcement officials.
