**Current Situation:** The fire is holding at the current perimeter. Firefighters continue to mop up the fire and are making great progress constructing a containment line. Weather conditions continue to be favorable. Demobilization of resources will continue today.

**Road Closures:** Highway 78 will remain closed from Wynola Road to S2 (Scissors Crossing), all other road closures were rescinded at 8 p.m. on Monday, September 17. **Residents of Lower Banner Grade** must access Highway 78 from S2 to avoid road hazards in the fire area. Only emergency vehicles will be allowed on Highway 78 between Wynola Road and the Lower Banner Grade Community.

**Evacuations:** All evacuations have been lifted.

**Additional Information:** Officials would like to thank residents of the Julian community for their rapid evacuation, cooperation, and patience during this emergency incident. Residents need to continually be prepared for the year-round fire season and make Defensible Space a priority.

**Tourist Information:** Julian is open for business. Fall is in the air, apples are ripe for picking and pies are in the oven. Visitors should make their plans now for a weekend getaway.
