



“Wild” Fire

Sonoma-Lake-Napa Unit

10:00 a.m.

Acreage: 3,750 acres

Containment: 40%

Location: East of Napa and northwest of Fairfield.

Weather: Predictions of temperature in the 80’s with possible winds to 30 mph.

Evacuations: Mandatory evacuations in place on Joyce Lane, Twin Sisters Road and Wooden Valley Roads in Napa and Solano County. Voluntary evacuations on Green Valley road North of Rockville Road in Solano County.

Engines: 63 Crews: 7 Helicopters: 3
Dozers: 13 Water Tenders: 6 Airtankers, as requested
Overhead: 54
Total personnel: 438

- The fire started on Saturday, June 21 at 4:00 p.m.
- One outbuilding (barn) destroyed.
- Evacuation center established at Fairfield Community Center
1000 Kentucky Street, Fairfield.
- 250 residents currently threatened – 2 commercial buildings –
50 outbuildings.
- One injury (heat exhaustion).
- Fire cause - under investigation.
