Acreage: 4,089 acres

Containment: 60% containment

Containment Date: 06/25/08

Location: East of Napa and northwest of Fairfield.

Weather: Predictions of temperature in the 80's with possible winds to 30 mph.

Evacuations: Mandatory evacuations in place on Joyce Lane.

Road Closures: Twin Sisters Road will be open below the burn to residents only. Green Valley Road is open. Gordon Valley Road, Wooden Valley Road and Suisun Valley Road will open to residents who can show valid ID.

- The fire started on Saturday, June 21 at 4 p.m.
- One outbuilding (barn) destroyed.
- Evacuation center now closed at the Fairfield Community Center, 1000 Kentucky Street, Fairfield.
- 125 residents currently threatened – 1 commercial buildings – 25 outbuildings.
- One injury (heat exhaustion).
- Fire cause – under investigation.
