Acreage: 8,000 acres

Location: Indian Valley Reservoir/Walker Ridge/Bear Valley, Lake County.
Moving East toward Walker Ridge – Bear Valley.

Weather: Weather conditions for today call for winds out of the SSW at 7 mph with gusts. The temperature is 95 degrees. The relative humidity is 13%.

Evacuations: Voluntary evacuations in place on Double Eagle Ranch (25 structures), Bear Valley Ranchland (1 structure) and Wilber Hot Springs (10 structures).

Road Closures: Possible Highway 20 closure.
