**Acreage:** 10,000 acres

**Containment:** 0%

**Location:** Indian Valley Reservoir/Walker Ridge/Bear Valley, Lake County.  
Fire moving East.

**Weather:** Weather conditions for today call for winds out of the SSW at 7 mph with gusts. The temperature is 95 degrees. The relative humidity is 13%.

**Evacuations:** Voluntary evacuations in place on Double Eagle Ranch (25 structures), Bear Valley Ranchland (1 structure) and Wilber Hot Springs (10 structures).

**Road Closures:** Walker Ridge is closed. Highway 20 is currently open.
