Current Situation: Firefighters continue to make good progress, despite the increase in a strong onshore wind that fanned the fire in a southeastern direction. Fire activity increased in the south and east areas of the fire today. Spotting occurred over primary containment line (Warnella Truck Trail), but all spots have been contained to this point. Tonight firefighters are working on keeping the fire west of Warnella Truck Trail and east of Swanton Rd.

Major problems and concerns continue to be the weather, steep terrain and limited access to the fire's perimeter. Conditions continue to be very fluid and may change quickly based on weather factors.

Firefighters will continue to construct fireline around the perimeter of the fire as conditions allow. Evacuations remain for the communities of Bonny Doon and Swanton. Firefighters remain in these communities constructing line and protecting structures.

Road Closures: Several road closures are in effect in the fire area and are being coordinated by the Santa Cruz County Sheriffs Department and the California Highway Patrol. Empire Grade from Felton Empire to Alba Rd has been reopened to residents with valid identification.

Evacuations: 2000 - 2400 people in the communities of Bonny Doon and Swanton have been evacuated.
