**Current Situation:** Last night, the weather continues to cooperate with firefighters allowing them to maintain the containment lines already established. in the areas of Warnella Truck Trail and Big Creek Road. Currently, ground and air resources are working the N/W and S/W portions of the fire to contain open fire line. Today only minor changes in the overall weather pattern are expected. as high pressure builds overhead. Night and morning low clouds will be common, bringing good fuel moisture recoveries

Firefighters continue to have great success with constructing fire line and mop-up around the entire perimeter of the fire. The Damage Inspection Team is continuing to evaluate the infrastructure to ensure a safe return for its residents.

Major problems and concerns continue to be the, steep terrain and limited access to some of the fire's perimeter. Significant heat along the line on the N/E corner and S/W corner is expected to be a concern for this and future operational periods. Conditions continue to be very fluid and may change quickly based on weather factors.

**Road Closures:** Several road closures are in effect in the fire area and being coordinated by the Santa Cruz County Sheriffs Department and the California Highway Patrol.

- Warnella Truck Trail @ Cement Plant
- Highway 1 @ Lower Swanton
- Highway 1 @ Upper Swanton
- Blodgett @ Empire Grade at Top end

**Evacuations:** Yesterday at 3:00 PM, the evacuation order in Bonny Doon area has been lowered to voluntary evacuation, allowing approximately 2200 residents to return with proof of residency. No additional evacuations are expected. Residents should remain diligent and continue to drive safe while both fire and law enforcement equipment will still be working in the area. Approximately 200 residents from Swanton area still remain evacuated.
