Current Situation: At 8:00 PM, mandatory evacuations were lifted in the Upper and Lower Swanton areas, including the community of Last Chance. However, there are still 20 residents displaced from the Warnella and Blodgett area. With an overnight marine layer, fire crews are expecting a reduction in fire behavior. Tonight's weather will continue to assist fire personnel in holding and constructing additional containment line. Firefighter's will continue to mop-up 300' within the fire's perimeter.

Major problems and concerns continue to be the, steep terrain and limited access to some of the fire's perimeter. Unshaded fuels have continued to burn well with runs of fire on steep slopes. Conditions continue to be very fluid and may change quickly based on weather factors. and terrain.

Road Closures: There are only two road closures being coordinated by the Santa Cruz County Sheriffs Department and the California Highway Patrol.
