Current Situation: Firing operations are progressing slower than anticipated. Yesterday, all road closures were lifted and all residents are encouraged to return to their places of residence. Residents will need to show proper identification to enter the effected area.

Firing operations are continuing in the Southern portion of the fire in order to contain remaining area of open line. This operation could take 1 to 2 days to complete. Residents in the area can expect some smoke production from these firing operations. Firefighter's continue to mop-up 300' within the fire's perimeter, and in all other areas.

Major problems and concerns continue to be the, steep terrain and limited access to some of the fire's perimeter. Conditions continue to be very fluid and may change quickly based on weather factors. and terrain. We would like residents driving in the communities affected by the fire to remain cautious of the fire personnel and equipment working to extinguish the fire. Additionally, residents need to be cautious when walking in or near the burned area. Smoldering brush and stumps may be found and are still dangerous.
