Current Situation: Firing operations saw significant gain yesterday and expect to continue burning in the southern portion of the fire. The threat of spot fires is still a concern for fire crews conducting the firing operations.

Major problems and concerns continue to be the, steep terrain and limited access to some of the fire's perimeter. Conditions continue to be very fluid and may change quickly based on weather factors and terrain. We would like residents driving in the communities affected by the fire to remain cautious of the fire personnel and equipment working to extinguish the fire. Additionally, residents need to be cautious when walking in or near the burned area. Smoldering brush and stumps may be found and are still dangerous.
