Current Situation: Firing operations have been successfully completed. Fire crews will continue to work in the southwest region of the incident to accomplish complete containment. Threat levels have been reduced in the Bonny Doon area however, residents should remain alert to possible fire activity occurring in the southwest region.

Major problems and concerns continue to be the, steep terrain and limited access. Lingering smoke will be present as fire crews continue to fully control the incident. We would like residents driving in the communities affected by the fire to remain cautious of the fire personnel and equipment working to extinguish the fire. Additionally, residents need to be cautious when walking in or near the burned area. Smoldering brush and stumps may be found and are still dangerous.

Road Closures There are no restrictions for residents in the burn area as of 7:00 PM Friday August 21, 2009. Law enforcement will be conducting normal operations in the region.
