Current Situation: Firefighters continue to monitor hot spots within the interior of the perimeter and assist the homeowners as they return to their property.

Evacuations: As of 7 p.m. Monday, August 31, all evacuations on the 49 Fire were lifted for residents with valid identification or proof of residency. County chaplains will be on hand for those residents whose homes were burned by the fire. Law enforcement officers will also have an increased patrol in the area.

PG&E crews continue to work to restore power and gas but isolated outages remain. To check on the status of power and gas, customers can contact 1-800-743-5000.
