Current Situation: Fire activity on the Eagle Fire is minimal. Remaining fire crews continue to construct containment lines, patrol the fire perimeter, and extinguish hot spots. Firefighters remain vigilant, faced with warm temperatures and low humidity. In conjunction with the Bureau of Indian Affairs and California State Parks and Recreation, a CAL FIRE Suppression Repair Team is working to mitigate the effects of fire control activities and impacts. Significant demobilization of firefighting resources is underway. The Lost Valley Boy Scout Camp will be open to the public on 7-29-2011.
