Current Situation: Fire activity on the Eagle Fire is minimal. Remaining fire crews will continue to construct control lines and patrol the fire perimeter. In conjunction with the Bureau of Indian Affairs and California State Parks and Recreation, a CAL FIRE Suppression Repair Team is working to mitigate the effects of fire control activities and prepare for potential erosion due to forecasted precipitation. Significant demobilization of firefighting resources continues. The Borrego Palm Canyon Campground and the Lost Valley Boy Scout Camp re-open today.
