Location: South West Kern County, Tehachapi Area

Cause: Lightning

Keene Complex is managing six fires totaling 10,470 acres. The fires are 100% contained and no structures have been damaged or destroyed:

Indian Fire - Acres: 3,295 - **Containment:** 100%

Cattle Fire - Acres: 2,130 - **Containment:** 100%

Baker Fire - Acres: 1,711 - **Containment:** 100%

Hart Fire - Acres: 283 - **Containment:** 100%

Harper Fire - Acres: 465 - **Containment:** 100%

Black Fire - Acres: 2,577 - **Containment:** 100%

Rodeo Fire - Acres: 9 - **Containment:** 100%

Current Situation:

Firefighters continue mop up, patrol and rehabilitation efforts. Please use extreme caution after the roads open at 0600 on 9-14-11

Recommended Evacuation Orders: None

Road Closures:

- Caliente Bodfish Road @ Loins Trail toward Twin Oaks will continue to be evaluated based on safety considerations.
