Current Situation: The wind throughout the day was extremely gusty, but firefighters worked hard to ensure the fire didn't leave the containment lines. Very little fire was witnessed today, with only a few hot spots, which were quickly extinguished. Tonight the firefighters will stay on the frontlines, continuing to build containment lines around the fire.

The increase in the fire's acreage was due to do more accurate GPS mapping.

Evacuations: All evacuations have been lifted.

Road Closures: Church Rd is opened to residents only from Old Hwy 80 to one mile north of Hwy 94. Old Hwy 80 was reopened earlier today.

Cooperating Agencies: CAL FIRE, San Diego County Fire Authority, local San Diego fire agencies, US Forest Service, Border Patrol, San Diego County Sheriff, California Highway Patrol, Red Cross & the Campo Indian Reservation.

Additional Information: Since the start of the fire, a CAL FIRE Fire Investigator has been working to determine the cause of the Old Fire. While the cause of the fire remains under investigation, the Investigator has been able to rule out electrical and lightning. There were no reports of lightning when the fire started and there are no powerlines in that area.
