Current Situation: Firefighters continue mopping up and patrolling for hot spots. Though the fire is 100% contained, crews will continue to be in the area for the next couple days ensuring that all the hot spots are out.

Evacuations: All evacuations have been lifted.

Road Closures: Church Rd is opened to residents only through the Camp Indian Reservation from Old Hwy 80 to one mile north of Hwy 94.

Cooperating Agencies: CAL FIRE, San Diego County Fire Authority, local San Diego fire agencies, US Forest Service, Border Patrol, San Diego County Sheriff, California Highway Patrol, Red Cross & the Campo Indian Reservation Fire Department.

Additional Information: As the firefighters now have the Old Fire 100% contained, CAL FIRE is taking the opportunity to thank all the cooperating agencies who responded to the fire and who assisted throughout the fire fight. The success of this incident was a direct result of the good interagency cooperation between the fire agencies.

Since the start of the fire, a CAL FIRE Fire Investigator has been working to determine the cause of the Old Fire. While the cause of the fire remains under investigation, the Investigator has been able to rule out electrical and lightning. There were no reports of lightning when the fire started and there are no powerlines in that area.
