Current Situation: Firefighting efforts continue to be hampered by heavy brush and timber in steep terrain. Lower temperatures today should allow for firefighters to proceed with line construction and control operations.

Evacuations: Evacuations remain in effect for homes off Yankee Jims & Southern part of Iowa Hill. The following streets are evacuated: Parts of Yankee Jims, Just Rd., Big Dipper Rd., Glory Mound Rd., Kings Hill Rd., Brushy Bear Rd., Brushy Creek Ln., Macy Creek, Adelin, Blind Doe, Mountain Lion, Spring Garden Rd, Log Cabin Ln, Pine Mountain Rd, Small Hope Mine Ln, Owl Creek Rd and parts of Shirrtail Canyon

Road Closures: Just Rd., Big Dipper Rd., Glory Mound Rd., Kings Hill Rd., Brushy Bear Rd., Brushy Creek Ln., Spring Garden Rd, Log Cabin Ln, Pine Mountain Rd, Small Hope Mine Ln, Owl Creek Rd and parts of Shirrtail Canyon, and parts of Shirrtail Canyon Rd. Evacuated roads remain closed.

Cooperating Agencies: CAL FIRE, local numerous fire agencies, Placer County Sheriff, CHP, CalEMA, Placer County OES, BLM, US Forest Service, CDCR & State parks.

Additional Information: The American Red Cross has established an evacuation shelter at the Foresthill High School.
