Current Situation: Firefighters made significant progress on the fire. Favorable weather conditions are continuing to aid firefighters in strengthening and holding fire lines. Unburned areas of brush, within containment lines, may continue to periodically burn.

Evacuations: Evacuations remain in effect for homes off Yankee Jims & Southern part of Iowa Hill. The following roads are evacuated: Spring Garden, Yankee Jims Ln., Small Hope Mine Ln., Owl Creek Rd., Pine Mountain Rd., Meritage Oak Ln., Kings Hill Rd., Brushy Creek Ln.

Road Closures: Just Rd., Big Dipper Rd., Glory Mound Rd., Kings Hill Rd., Brushy Bear Rd., Brushy Creek Ln., Spring Garden Rd, Log Cabin Ln., Pine Mountain Rd., Small Hope Mine Ln., Owl Creek Rd., parts of Shirttail Canyon, and parts of Shirttail Canyon Rd. Evacuated roads remain closed.

Cooperating Agencies: Placer County Sheriff, Placer County OES, Placer County Animal Control, California National Guard, CHP, CalEMA, BLM, CDCR, State Parks, and BOR.

Additional Information: The American Red Cross has established an evacuation shelter at the Foresthill High School. Animal Shelter is located at the Pleasant Street entrance of the Gold Country Fairgrounds.
