**Current Situation:** Crews remain focused on improvement of containment lines and continued extinguishment of hot spots and smoldering areas within the fire perimeter and patrolling all areas of the fire. In conjunction with these efforts the plan for fire suppression repair has been integrated. However, very steep and rugged terrain remains a cause of concern for firefighter safety. Acreage has been reduced due to more accurate mapping.
