Current Situation: Work continues on strengthening and improving control lines. Mop up and control will continue for several days. Excess resources are being identified and being released. Damage inspection and fire suppression damage repair efforts have begun.

HWY 20 is open to restricted speed traffic in both directions. Traffic is restricted to 45 miles per hour. C.H.P. is enforcing traffic restrictions.

Residents are reminded that at times there may be smoke seen within the containment line. Firefighters will be in the patrol and mop up phase for the next several days mitigating any interior hot spots.

Evacuations: All evacuation orders have been lifted.

Evacuation Centers: All evacuation centers have been closed

Cooperating Agencies: CAL FIRE, Lake County Sheriff's Office, Colusa County Sheriff's Office, CHP, CALEMA, CAL TRANS, PG&E, Red Cross, Bureau of Land Management, CCC and CA Dept. of Corrections and Rehabilitation

Additional Information: Due to fire conditions and fire fighter safety, hunting has been restricted 10 miles north and south of Hwy 20, between Hwy 53 and Hwy 16. CAL FIRE Incident Management Team 4 (IMT 4) remains in command of the incident. Please use caution when driving in the area of Hwy 20 and Spring Valley due to personnel and equipment use in the area.
