Current Situation: The fire is 100% contained. Smoke may be visible within the fire perimeter for several days. Firefighting personnel and equipment will remain in the fire area for mop-up and patrol operations. Motorists are encouraged to use extreme caution and reduced speed while driving in the fire area. Fire suppression damage repair continues.

Evacuations: All evacuation orders have been lifted.

Evacuation Centers: All evacuation centers have been closed.

Cooperating Agencies: CAL FIRE, Lake County Sheriff’s Office, Colusa County Sheriff’s Office, CHP, CALEMA, CAL TRANS, PG&E, Red Cross, Bureau of Land Management, CCC and CA Dept. of Corrections and Rehabilitation

Additional Information: Hunting restrictions in the area 10 miles North & South of Highway 20 between Highway 53 and Highway 16 have been lifted. Exercise extreme caution as firefighting personnel will remain in the area for several days. Lake County will host a community meeting for those who have been affected by the fires. The meeting will be held at the Moose Lodge located at 15900 Highway 20 in Clearlake Oaks on Monday August 20, 2012 at 6:00 p.m.
