SUMMARY OF INCIDENT:

On August 24, 2012 at 12:00pm the evacuation warning for the area of Hwy 36 from the vista point to Mineral has expired. Residents may return to Canyon View Loop and to the area east of Cedar Ridge Road and Forward Road in Manton, from the road control point to the edge of the burn perimeter. Residents will need to present proper identification to be allowed through the road closure.

Drinking water is available Manton School while the Boole Ditch water system is being repaired. Residents are encouraged to minimize usage of the schools water during the hours 8:00am to 3:30pm, due to school being in session. Remember, the Manton School is a **Tobacco Free Zone** and no smoking is permitted on school grounds

The Red Cross will be providing a limited amount of bottled water at the Manton School starting Saturday, August 25, 2012 through Monday, August 27, 2012, between the hours of 8:00am to 6:00pm.
