Current Situation: Repairs to damage caused by firefighting efforts continue to be made throughout the fire area. Fire damaged trees exist and may present a hazard. Two destroyed bridges on Rock Creek Road have been identified. We urge the public to use caution on roadways in and around the fire area while fire crews are still present. A Red Flag Warning is in effect for tomorrow, August 28th due to high winds and low relative humidity.

There are no evacuation warnings.

Evacuation Center: The Red Cross Shelter at Big League Dreams is closed. No further evacuation center activations are anticipated.

Road Closures: All road closures have been lifted.
