Cooperating Agencies: CAL FIRE, Covelo Fire Department, USDA Forest Service, Bureau of Indian Affairs, California Dept. of Corrections & Rehabilitation, California National Guard and Mendocino County Sheriff's Department.

Additional Information: Pass Complex is 2 separate fires in same area. Pass 1 Fire has burned into the Mendocino National Forest. CAL FIRE is in unified command with USDA Forest Service. Pass 2 Fire jumped the fire line & is burning east towards the Pass 1 Fire.
