Current Situation: Firefighters were successful today with their efforts to improve control lines and further contain the fire. Smoke continues to rise from hot spots located primarily within the interior sections. Further spread of the fire is expected to be very minimal, if any at all. A number of engines and firefighters are being released and reallocated to other incidents including the Scotts Fire north of Clear Lake.

Road Closures: There are currently no road closures. Highway 16 has been reopened. A smoke advisory for Highways 16 and 20 is in effect due to the possibility of decreased visibility in the area. Motorists are advised to use extra caution and to be alert for fire vehicles and the possibility of debris on the roadway.

Evacuations: There are no current evacuation orders.
