Current Situation: Firefighters worked overnight to further strengthen control lines and extinguish hot spots. Smoke continues to rise from some areas, primarily within the interior sections. The fire is not expected to spread beyond the current control lines. Significant efforts have begun to repair any damage caused by suppression efforts with the goal of preventing any future environmental damage. Firefighters and equipment continue to be released from the incident.

Road Closures: There are currently no road closures. Motorists are advised to use extra caution and to be alert for fire vehicles and the possibility of debris on the roadway.

Evacuations: There are no current evacuation orders.
