**Current Situation:** Fire containment lines have been constructed around the fire perimeter. Containment increased today and crews will continue throughout the night to strengthen fire control lines and work on active fire areas within the perimeter. As containment of the fire increases, fire equipment and personnel will be made available for release or reassignment to other fires. Fire suppression repair operations have begun and will continue in the fire area for several weeks.

**Evacuations:** None

**Road Closures and Conditions:** Scotts Valley Road is open to residents only. Mendo Rock Road Access to North Cow Mountain Road is closed at Mill Creek. Mill Creek Road is closed. Fire equipment will remain in the area for several days and residents are urged to use caution while traveling in the surrounding area.

The Cow Mountain Recreation Area has been closed at both the Scotts Creek and Mill Creek entrances. Glen Eden and Valley View Trails are closed.
