EVACUATIONS: Tierra Del Sol area

ROAD CLOSURES: Highway 94 at Tierra del Sol

COOPERATING AGENCIES: CAL FIRE San Diego Unit, San Diego County Sheriff's Department, Campo Indian Reservation Fire, Bureau of Land Management, US Border Patrol

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Only area under evacuation is the Tierra del Sol area. Road closure remains at Highway 94 from Shockey Truck Trail to Jewell Valley Road to the International Border of Mexico.

San Diego Sheriff's Department/Coroner is handling the investigation regarding the fatality on September 24, 2012.

The objective today is to continue to build containment lines on the northern and southern flanks.

**UPDATED:** The evacuation order for Tierra del Sol will be lifted at **4:00 PM today**. Only residents with ID will be allowed to return.
