Current Situation: Fire is burning with a moderate rate of spread on both sides of the Owens River. There is a threat to 230 and 500 Kv lines in the fire area. Threat to livestock in the area has been mitigated. Firefighters from CAL FIRE, the Inyo National Forest, the Bureau of Land Management and local agencies are fighting the fire and additional resources from CAL FIRE are in route to assist in fire-fighting efforts. No structures have been damaged or destroyed by the fire. There have been no injuries reported.
