
Current Situation: Conditions continue to be windy and dry. Burning in timber and timber slash. Moderate to rapid rate of spread continues in steep terrain. Fire remains in the Mill Creek and Deer Creek drainages. There is no imminent structure or infrastructure threat. The predicted and resulting erratic winds increased fire activity last night and during the course of today. The aggressive action of firefighters continues to minimize the fire spread. Use of fire crews is still critical due to rugged terrain. Fire activities will not impact the planned activities at Silver Dollar Fairgrounds during the weekend. Fire continues to burn in the Ishi Wilderness Area. Red Flag Warning in the fire area will remain in effect until 9:00 pm tonight. Strong northeast winds, low relative humidity and thunder cells with dry lightning followed by potential precipitation are forecasted.

Road Closures: The area between Highway 32 and Highway 36 known as the Deer Creek and Mill Creek Recreation Area as well as the Ishi Wilderness are closed to the public. Highway 32 and Highway 36 will remain open but be aware of the heavy fire equipment traffic on those highways.


Evacuations: None

Additional Information: Uncharacteristic fire behavior for this time of year is due to the record dry winter and spring. Over the last week there have been over 150 fires in northern California.

Cooperating Agencies: USFS (Lassen and Plumas NF), CDCR, SPI, Collins Pine, Chico Fire Department, CHP, BCSO, and TCSO, Butte County Air Quality.
